65.01 THROUGH STREETS – STOP. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop, unless a yield is permitted by this chapter, before entering an intersection with the following designated through streets.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. County Road V-18 from the south City limits to the north City limits;
2. F-29 (Old Highway 6) from the east City limits to the west City limits;
3. Jackson Street from its intersection of Front Street to the north City limits.

65.02 STOP REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. At all entrances to Jackson Street (County Highway V-18) of all streets from the north City limits to Second Street, inclusive, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
2. At all entrances to Old Highway 6 (County Highway F-29) from the west City limits to the drive from the senior citizens housing, approximately 250 feet west of Jackson Street, inclusive, traffic from the north and south shall stop.
3. At Front Street from High Street, the north-south alley west of Jackson, and Jackson Street, inclusive, traffic from the north shall stop; and traffic entering Front Street from the Post Office parking from the south shall stop.
4. At the railroad crossings on Mills Street, traffic from north and south shall stop.
5. At East Pershing Drive and Mills Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
6. At Mills Street and Pleasant Street and East Green Streets, traffic from east shall stop.
7. At East Pershing Drive and Center Street, traffic from north and south shall stop.
8. At Clay Street and East Pershing Drive, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
9. At West Street and West Des Moines Street, traffic from south shall stop.
10. At Park Avenue and West Des Moines Street, traffic from north shall stop.
11. At Park Avenue and Summit Street, traffic from west shall stop.

12. At Broadway and Pleasant Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
13. At Boundary Street and East Des Moines Street, traffic from east and south shall stop.
14. At Clay Street and Front Street, traffic from west shall stop.
15. At Ramsey Street and Brady Street, traffic from north and south shall stop.
16. At South Jackson Street and Brady Street, traffic from south shall stop.
17. At South Jackson Street and Lincoln Street, traffic from west shall stop.
18. At Clay Street and Third Street, traffic from west shall stop.
19. At East Pleasant Street and Center Street, traffic from north shall stop.
20. At Center Street and Middle Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
21. At East Green and Broadway, traffic from east and west shall stop.
22. At East Green Street and Clay Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
23. At Pershing Drive and Monroe, traffic from north going south shall stop.
24. At Winter and Center Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
25. At East Main and Mills Street, traffic from east and west shall stop.
26. At Williams and East Second, traffic from north going south shall stop.
27. At Williams and East Pleasant Street, traffic from north going south shall stop.
28. At Adams Street and Green, traffic from north going south shall stop.
29. At Brady and Clinton, traffic from south going north shall stop.
30. At Park Avenue and Bellevue Street, traffic from the north and south shall stop.
31. At Clay Street and Pleasant Street, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
32. At Clay Street and Second Street, traffic from the east shall stop.
33. At Center Street and East Des Moines Street, traffic from the north shall stop.
34. At Ramsey Street and Jefferson Street, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
35. At Clay and East Main, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
36. At Clay and East Des Moines, traffic from the south shall stop.
37. At Link Circle and Bear Drive, traffic from the south shall stop.
38. At Bear Drive and Jackson Street, traffic from the east shall stop.
39. At Williams Street and Pleasant Street, traffic from the south shall stop.
40. At Center Street and East Des Moines Street, traffic from the south shall stop.
41. At Pleasant Street and Mills Street, traffic from the west shall stop.
42. At Third Street and Broadway Street, traffic from the east shall stop.
43. At Third Street and Clay Street, traffic from the east shall stop.

44. At North Clay Street and North Street, traffic from the north shall stop.
45. At Brooklyn Circle and North Street, traffic from the south shall stop.
46. At Sunset and West Green Street, traffic from the north shall stop.
47. At Williams Street and East Des Moines Street, traffic from the south shall stop.
48. At Broadway and Third Street, traffic from the east and west shall stop.
49. At Alice and Clay Streets, traffic from the east shall stop.
50. At Broadway and East Des Moines Street, traffic from the south shall stop.
51. At Clay Street and East Pershing Drive, traffic from the north and south shall stop.
52. At Broadway Street and East Second Street, traffic from the east and north shall stop.
53. At Mills Street and East Pershing Drive, traffic from the north and south shall stop.
54. At Williams Street and East Pershing Drive, traffic from the north and south shall stop.
55. At Monroe Street and West Des Moines Street, traffic from the south going north shall stop. *(Ord. 2019-03 – Mar. 20 Supp.)*
56. At Adams Street and West Pershing Street, traffic from the south going north shall stop. *(Ord. 2019-06 – Mar. 20 Supp.)*

65.03 THREE-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated three-way stop intersections:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. At the intersection of Mills Street and North Street, traffic from the east, south and west shall stop.
2. At the intersection of Center Street and Spring Street, traffic from the east, west and north shall stop.
3. At the intersection of Center Street and North Street, traffic from the east, south and west shall stop.

65.04 FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated four-way stop intersections:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. At the intersection of Mills Street and East Des Moines Street, traffic from each direction shall stop.
2. At the intersection of South Orchard Street and Brady Street, traffic from each direction shall stop.
3. At the intersection of East Pershing Drive and Broadway, traffic from each direction shall stop.

65.05 YIELD REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall yield in accordance with the following:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. At Clay Street and Railroad Alley, traffic from east shall yield.
2. At Broadway and Main Street, traffic from east and west shall yield.
3. At Broadway and Second Street, traffic from east shall yield.
4. At Mills Street and Second Street, traffic from west shall yield.
5. At North Orchard Street and Linden Drive, traffic from east shall yield.
6. At North Orchard Street and Front Street, traffic from east shall yield.
7. At High Street and Linden Drive, traffic from west shall yield.
8. At South Orchard Street and Jefferson Street, traffic from north shall yield.
9. At North Orchard Street and West Pershing Drive, traffic from the south shall yield.
10. At Second Street and Business Alley, traffic from the south shall yield.
11. At Clay Street and Third Street, traffic from the east shall yield.

65.06 SCHOOL STOPS. When a driver of a vehicle approaches an authorized school stop said driver shall bring the vehicle to a full stop at a point ten (10) feet from the approach side of the crosswalk marked by an authorized school stop sign and thereafter proceed in a careful and prudent manner until the vehicle shall have passed the school site.

65.07 STOP BEFORE CROSSING SIDEWALK. The driver of a vehicle emerging from a private roadway, alley, driveway, or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto the sidewalk area and thereafter shall proceed into the sidewalk area only when able to do so without danger to pedestrian traffic and shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicular traffic on the street into which the vehicle is entering.

65.08 STOP WHEN TRAFFIC IS OBSTRUCTED. Notwithstanding any traffic control signal indication to proceed, no driver shall enter an intersection or a marked crosswalk unless there is sufficient space on the other side of the intersection or crosswalk to accommodate the vehicle.

65.09 YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS IN CROSSWALKS. Where traffic control signals are not in place or in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, slowing down or stopping, if need be, to yield to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within any marked crosswalk or within any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection.
