# TELEPHONE FRANCHISE

### 110.01 Franchise Granted

### 110.02 Police Power

**110.01 FRANCHISE GRANTED.** Permission and authority are hereby granted for the period of twenty-five (25) years from and after the acceptance of this franchise, as herein provided, to the Brooklyn Mutual Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, to acquire, construct and maintain in the City, as the same is now or may hereafter be extended or located, the necessary facilities for the receiving and transmitting of message or other electronic communications, by telephone, telegraph or other means, using wires, cables, carriers, microwaves and/or electronic and/or other methods for public or private use, and to sell and furnish telephone, telegraph or other communication service to the City and its inhabitants, for all purposes and to construct and maintain along, upon, across or under the streets, highways, avenues, alleys, bridges and other public places the necessary fixtures, apparatus and equipment for such purposes.

**110.02 POLICE POWER.** The rights herein granted are subject to the exercise of the police power as the same now is or may hereafter be conferred upon the City.
